## A Reflection from James Hogan *Cut-Flower Christianity*

*Remain in me, as I remain in you.  
Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own  
unless it remains on the vine,  
so neither can you unless you remain in me.*

“New Atheist” Richard Dawkins, in a recent interview, called himself a “cultural Christian.” He was quick to clarify that he is “not a believer” of Christianity, but told the interviewer, “I love hymns and Christmas carols, and I sort of feel at home in the Christian ethos. I feel that we are a Christian country in that sense.” This exchange was in reaction to seeing England full of lights celebrating the Muslim holiday of Ramadan. Beyond mere aesthetics, Dawkins also stated that he likes to “live in a culturally Christian country” because it is kind to women and tolerant of homosexuals, whereas Islam is fundamentally hostile to both.

Richard Dawkins is a foolish man. He is admiring the beauty of a flower that he is trying to sever from its roots, which will ensure its decay. He can be likened to a foolish man:

There once was a foolish man who loved apples. He loved to hold them, juggle them, bake them, and eat them. But the foolish man hated apples trees. So, the foolish man spent his life cutting down as many apple trees as possible. The foolish man never worried about not having apples, because he could always buy apples at the grocery store. Any child can tell you why that man is foolish. So can we. Richard Dawkins cannot. He does not see that the faith that inspired those beautiful hymns and constructed those magnificent cathedrals is the very faith he has dedicated his life to undermining.

Truth and goodness are first things. Beauty is a second thing. It is the child of the union of truth and goodness. Beauty points beyond itself. Beauty points back to first things, though we do not always grasp its connection back to its roots of truth and goodness when contemplating it. Put truth and goodness first and beauty follows it and flourishes. Isolate beauty and it will wither like a cut-flower. Catholic “CEOs” (Christmas-Easter-Only) are admiring the beauty of a flower they have cut from its source, making its withering inevitable. Jesus understood this only too well:

*I am the vine, you are the branches.  
Whoever remains in me  
and I in him will bear much fruit,  
because without me you can do nothing.  
Anyone who does not remain in me  
will be thrown out like a branch and wither.*

Many Catholics today are like Richard Dawkins, living a kind of “cut-flower Christianity,” admiring the aesthetic surface of faith without seeing the Christ-roots that nourish it. So, the next time you admire a flower – or apple for that matter – praise the roots that gave life to it.

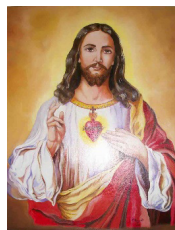

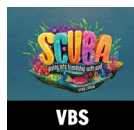

NEW Protocol for scheduling Mass Intentions.

- Masses will be scheduled for six months at a time.
- One month prior to the start of that six-month cycle, we'll open Mass Intention scheduling to the parish.

While there are many Masses scheduled already for July through December, we are beginning the new process now. Beginning June 1, we'll schedule Masses through December. Then, on December 1, we'll begin scheduling Masses for January through June.

Other ways we can bring our loved ones with our hearts to God's Heart of Love! Here are some suggestions that also are spiritually beneficial. Remember, instead of individual Masses, you can create the intention "For the family of...(living or deceased). | Light a candle, say a prayer. | Pray a Rosary for your loved one. | Find a prayer chain in the parish. Quite often, the different prayer groups in the parish send out individual prayer requests. | Add their name to our yearly prayer calendar created by our school. | During Consecration of the Blessed Sacrament, with your heart, speak that person's name. This is a very beautiful way to bring any of our family members or friends to the Supper Table of the Lord. | Local shrines usually have opportunities to have your loved ones included in daily prayer for sometimes a year at a time.

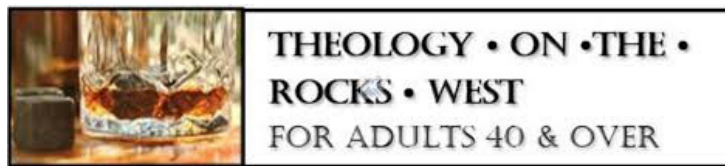

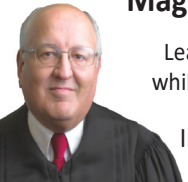
